Happy summer! The young men at O'Connell Youth Ranch have finished out the school year, most of which was done remotely, and now seem to be excited about summer.

They will be busy with a trip to the Art Institute, holding exercise club sessions, taking care of the garden, continuing to beautify the grounds of the ranch, riding horses, and swimming. Those who want can participate in a bible study and in life skills programming. We have a couple of young men who have jobs, some are doing Drivers Ed and a couple are doing football workouts.



Outside of this, we have several different trips planned. The boys and staff from one house are going to South Dakota camping and all the boys and staff are planning a day trip to Worlds of Fun.

The staff is busy working on accreditation which will allow us to give a higher level of care and which offers many therapeutic components. The accreditation people have been here looking at policies and practices. They gave us additional components to improve on while they evaluate us. It will be weeks before we know if we passed the "test" but we are very hopeful. This accreditation will allow us to add to our continuum of care so that we can take care of more children and their families long term.
